Cars for Homes Qs & As

Q: How much can I deduct?

A: Once your vehicle is sold, the selling price determines the amount of your donation. If your vehicle sells for more than \$500, you may deduct the full selling price. If your vehicle sells for \$500 or less, you can deduct the "fair market value" of your vehicle, up to \$500.


