On a cold December morning in Havre de Grace in 2018, we raised the walls of Kathryn's house, one of seven Habitat homes planned for our first-ever subdivision. We were building those homes even in the midst of a global pandemic when we were down to a skeleton crew, and volunteers groups were restricted while we practiced safe social distancing. Now, on January 20th, we're holding a house dedication for the last of the homes there. This subdivision. located on the intersection of Stokes and Revolution Streets, was originally nicknamed the "Revolutionary Homeownership Project" as a salute to the idea that affordable homeownership for low-income families offers a dramatic change in people's lives. In the spirit of what this idea represents, I want to thank all of you -- our sponsors, donors, volunteers and advocates -- for your unwavering support of our vision where everyone has a decent place to live. This year, we'll be celebrating our 30th anniversary building homes, communities and hope. I look forward to all of the great things we can and will do together in 2023!




January anniversaries
