Dad used to carry his daughter out of the house to appointments, but mom is unable to lift her daughter alone. Habitat already had installed a chair lift on one side of the house when it was first built, but mom needs a ramp on the other side. Could you help us build a ramp at this Havre de Grace home?

We are looking for groups of up to 10 people every Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 8am to 3pm. No experience required. Volunteers just need to be 16 years or older. Veteran & wife have daughter with Parkinson's; need help while Repair Program makes their ONLY bathroom handicap accessible at Elkton home



We have a family who will be receiving help from our Repair Program through grants we receive to assist low-income homeowners. The husband is a Veteran, 84 y.o., his wife is 76 y.o., and they have a 50 y.o. daughter who lives with them and has Parkinson's. The family has only one bathroom in their small Elkton home and it is not handicap accessible. The bathroom work that we're scheduling contractors to do in July will take about six days. This means the family must live in a hotel during that time (they don't have anywhere else they could go) but our grants don't cover expenses like hotel stays. 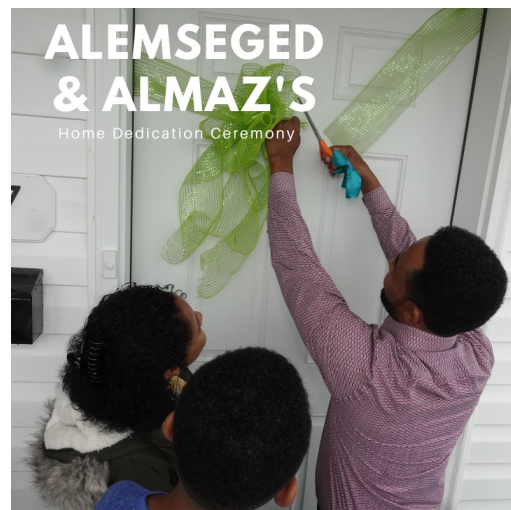
