## Meet a homeowner helped by the Repair Program

The story of Thomas by Heather Gibson, Repair Program Specialist



Longtime Harford County residents, Thomas and Mary, purchased their home in 1996. Over the past 25 years, health issues arose, along with mounting home repair needs. Having a limited income, they turned to a friend who suggested they reach out to a program that recently assisted her with obtaining a new roof -- our Repair Program.

"From the beginning everyone was absolutely wonderful. The application process was so easy and the flow made us so comfortable," stated Mary.

Upon the initial visit, the Repair Program Manager noticed many critical repairs that needed to be addressed, particularly the leaking roof and the basement door which allowed for basement flooding during rainy days. Along with those repairs, and thanks to the generous grant funding through the **Community Development Block Grant**, the Repair Program was able to address the issues, and replace their outdated HVAC system, sub pump and insulation.

"I worked for a construction company for 30 years and have never seen a job completed so well. The construction guys went above and beyond -- even kept my house clean!" said Mary.

"We now have security," Thomas added. "We no longer need to stress. Our house is now comfortable and we can walk outside through our door without any worry."

Also, as a result of the repairs, Thomas and Mary have seen a reduction in their BGE costs and during a recent rainstorm, there was no basement flooding!

"I can't thank Habitat enough," said Mary. "The service was remarkable and we cannot begin to tell you how much this group touched our hearts."
