Did you know? In this month...

June 2006: The first "Builders Blitz Build" occurred, involving two Habitat home builds in Aberdeen. The companies **Bob Ward** and **Pulte Homes** did a friendly competition to see which builder's team could complete a Habitat home first. Both homes were completed in four days, and a dedication ceremony was held for the houses on the fifth day.

June 2011: Habitat for Humanity of Cecil County and Harford Habitat for Humanity merged to create Habitat for Humanity Susquehanna. The merger was celebrated later that September with a public dedication held at Cherry Lane, Elkton, the site of the first home built by the newly-merged affiliate.

June 2013: Dedication ceremony was held for the "House that Bel Air Built." It was the first Habitat home built in the Bel Air town limits. Over 300 volunteers worked on the home.

June 2013: The painted "Habitat Heart" that resides in front of the Habitat Susquehanna office building was unveiled at a dedication ceremony with Bel Air Downtown Alliance.


