Habitat for Humanity Susquehanna Will Hold Groundbreaking Ceremony in Elkton
Cecil "Habi-Tech" home will be transported to Manor Road in the near future

ELKTON, MD (March 14, 2023) -- Habitat for Humanity Susquehanna will hold a groundbreaking ceremony for a Habitat home that was built by the students of the Cecil County School of Technology (CCST) in partnership with Habitat Susquehanna. It is the fourth time that Habitat Susquehanna has purchased a "Habi-Tech" home built by the CCST. (Previous years/locations: 2021/Rising Sun; 2019/Perryville; 2011/Elkton). After the ground is broken and foundation poured, the home will be transported to its final, permanent location on Manor Road, Elkton. The homebuyer for this Habitat house is Felicia Hanna, a single mother of three.

WHAT: A groundbreaking ceremony is being held to announce upcoming preparations for the Cecil "Habi-Tech" house to be moved to its final location.

NOTE: There is a possibility that the ground may be broken and foundation poured by the time of this event; however, it is a ceremonial occasion to mark an important milestone in this homeownership process. The event will also launch an announcement of the opportunity for volunteers to help complete the house once it has been transported to Elkton.

WHEN: Wednesday, March 22

WHERE: 2 Manor Road, Elkton, Cecil County.

NOTE: This event will take place at 2 Manor Road in the Elkwood Estates neighborhood (not Hollingsworth Manor, which also has a similar address).

WHO: Invitees to attend this ceremony include: Habitat Susquehanna staff and Board members; local officials; local media; CCST representatives; house sponsors; the Hanna family and friends; and, Habitat Susquehanna volunteers.
