

ABOUT THE REPAIR PROGRAM

Our Repair Program provides critical home repairs to lowincome qualified homeowners in Harford and Cecil Counties to alleviate health and safety issues, such as floors, walls, roofs, HVAC, minor plumbing, electrical, and accessibility needs/modifications. All applicants must make a small financial contribution towards the cost of their critical home repairs as part of Habitat's philosophy that homeowners participate in the "hand up" that we're giving to them. (Contribution fee must be paid in full before work can begin.)

Our Repair Program additionally provides weatherization assistance to improve energy efficiency and indoor air quality to homes.

Only one application is needed to cover any requests for critical home repairs and weatherization.

NOTE: There are fake social media ads claiming that Habitat for Humanity is giving away free services. (i.e.., roof replacements, bathroom remodel). This is a scam. Please report these posts to have them removed.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The need for assistance is determined by the qualifications review process and a subsequent home visit assessment. All applicants must reside in Harford or Cecil Counties and have a household income at or under HUD's 80 percent Area Median Income limits (see chart below). Repairs are restricted to owner-occupied residential properties.

Currently, our waiting list is full and we are not accepting new applications.
