

The Habitat for Humanity Susquehanna Repair Program: Veterans' Eligibility Requirements



Habitat for Humanity Susquehanna is a participant in Habitat for Humanity International's *Repair Corps* program, an initiative funded by The Home Depot Foundation to help to help build, rehabilitate or repair the homes of U.S. military veterans and their families.

The Home Depot Foundation supports Habitat's *Repair Corps* program on projects ranging from new construction to home repair projects such as roofing, weatherproofing, installation of access ramps and kitchen or bathroom renovations for wheelchair access.

Qualified applicants that demonstrate the greatest need for a Habitat repair will be selected. Need is determined by a home assessment and financial/income eligibility. All repair projects are subject to availability of funds.

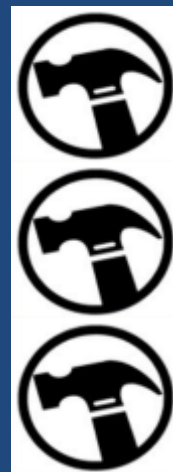
RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must reside in Harford or Cecil counties. Repairs are restricted to residential properties in Harford and Cecil counties.

FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must provide their most recent and consecutive bank statements, monthly income (i.e., two months' pay stubs), two years' tax returns and additional requested documentation listed on checklist

Checklist of Eligibility Requirements for Veterans



Any U.S. Veteran who has received an honorable discharge. DD-214 must be provided.

The Veteran does not need to be the owner of the home but must reside in home as his/her Primary residence. Cannot be a renter.

Home must have active and valid homeowners' insurance.

ELIGIBLE REPAIRS

Approved projects include interior and exterior work performed to alleviate critical health, life and safety issues or code violations, and include, but are not limited to:

- roof repairs and replacement
- damage to floors or structural walls
- handicap accessibility renovations
- electrical, plumbing and HVAC
- minor upgrades such as painting, caulking & insulation

NOTE: Active military and widows/widowers of Veterans are not eligible.
